


ERCOT Real Time Grid and Market Conditions





Texas Market Structure





NRG's Generation Footprint




Matching assets to customers



- Returned to operation August 21, 2023
- Accounts for 15% of WA Parish output
- 600 MW power to Texas
- Repair is faster and lower cost than building new generation
- 750,000 homes served


